This 2-day virtual online LIVE course is designed to give learners comprehensive skills and in-depth knowledge to plan and 2020 ERSEA Federal Monitoring and Unannounced Reviews. This course will focus on comprehensive ERSEA monitoring reviews as well as will also incorporate the changes with the NEW Focus Area One requirement processes. Students will understand how to ensure questions are properly answer ERSEA questions and temporary ERSEA policies and procedures are justified during COVID. You will also learn how to setup systems for key answers on COVID Eligibility, Enrollment and Attendance processes. As a benefit, learners will find that this course is an in-depth approach to ensuring program practices for verifying the eligibility, virtual attendance, and full enrollment of children into the program. Students will also gain comprehensive knowledge to plan and generate monitoring reports that will help eliminate fraud. The ERSEA Online LIVE course is a plus for any program scheduled for federal review. (It is recommended that all students trained prior to September 15 get this update of this training.)
